

The Sled £50,000 -£100,000

The most vital piece of equipment that can provide the competitive edge for any team taking seconds away from the clock, Sled technology has improved since our sled was manufactured in 2011, a world calibre 2-man sled can be rented for £8000 or purchased new at £50000. A World Class 4-man sled can cost up to £100,000.



Runners £5000- £10,000

The Runners are what contact the ice, they provide the pilot with different levels of friction depending on the specification, a high quality set can improve speed and handling characteristics. In the same way a premium tyre can increase a cars performance.



Travel & Subsistence £35,000

The team needs to travel across Europe to reach events, necessary costs such as vehicle hire, accommodation, fuel ,food and race fees all take up a valuable mark on resources. The more we spend here the less we have to put towards the equipment that can make the competitive difference on ice.


